ORGANIZATION SUMMARY



Portland Farmers Market (PFM) is a nonprofit organization in Portland, Oregon with approximately 15 full and part time staff, including a Market Operations team composed of the Operations Director, two Farmers Market Managersand multiple Market Crew members. PFM operates five vibrant farmers markets that provide customers with a direct connection to our 200 vendors with deep roots in Oregon and Washington. These vendors include farms, nurseries, bakeries, meat and seafood providers, cheese makers and specialty food producers.

POSITION SUMMARY

Senior Market Crew members work with minimal supervision to provide operational support at our farmers markets. They drive our market trucks, set up/tear down equipment, conduct PFM sales and services to shoppers and vendors at the market, and work collaboratively with fellowstaff to ensure that our market runs smoothly. Successful Senior Market Crew members approach work with a positive, team-minded attitude and are able to perform tasks independently in outdoor environments with a consideration for timeliness.

This position requires the ability to lift equipment weighing up to 50 pounds, step up and down out of a truck, set up canopies and carry large boxes, work on your feet for extended periods, and walk over uneven terrain. PSU Farmers Market operates outdoors year-round, and working conditions may include rain, wind, hot and freezing temperatures.

POSITION DUTIES

Market Logistics & Safety

- Assist in ensuring that all necessary equipment/supplies are maintained according to policy and otherwise left in good working order.
- Assist in monitoring safety and accessibility concerns during the market's open hours.
- Assist with Durable Dining dish return and waste management.
- Communicate vendor attendance and market logistics to market managers
- Direct safe traffic of vehicles operating on and around market site as assigned.
- Report emergencies and safety concerns to market manager.
- Follow directions to directly support the success, safety and integrity of the market as assigned.
- Follow and offer support for PFM's crisis response plan when necessary.
- Gain a working knowledge of PFM's policies and procedures at the market.
- Drive market vehicle (van or box truck) between PFM office and market location(s).

Sales and Service

- Conduct at-market sales and customer service related to token distribution, merchandise, and vendor payments.
- Assist with tracking and recording market tokens, merchandise inventory and vendor payments.
- Maintain supportive relationships with vendors, be familiar with their products and practices and promote their success.
- Provide information to shoppers about methods of payment accepted at the markets including market tokens, matching programs and vouchers.

Team Participation

- Work collaboratively to improve and expand efficiency of work.
- Contribute to the inclusivity of our markets and work environment by building positive relationships.
- Assist with marketing and promotion of the farmers market as assigned.
